* Confirm with dot plot and/or blood film review.

1. Increased RDW - Anisocytosis present - review blood film.
2. Platelet aggregates are detected. Platelet count may be higher than reported.
3. Increased MCHC or MCH - Consider hemolysis (including sample collection/handling), lipemia, and Heinz bodies.
